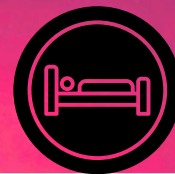

WSRBA SHOW RULES

1. This will be an Official ARBA show governed by the Official Show Rules in the ARBA Yearbook. All rabbits and caviae will be judged by the ARBA Standard of Perfection 2021-2025 edition.
2. All rabbits and caviae will be judged as written on the entry forms and all changes must be approved by the show secretary. Moving a rabbit to another class without secretary approval will result in disqualification of the rabbit. Ear Changes will be \$2.00 per change.
3. Make all checks payable to WSRBA in US Funds. A \$30.00 fee will be charged for any returned checks.
4. Entries must be paid for before the rabbits or caviae are judged.
5. All entries must be paid whether the rabbits or caviae are judged or not. (No refunds on Scratched animals) No shows will be billed.
6. If an exhibitor has outstanding fees to other clubs, these must be paid before your entry will be accepted.
7. Legs and show reports will be emailed. Ribbons must be picked at the show.
8. WSRBA reserves the right to add, substitute, or cancel judges as conditions require.
9. Judges' decisions will be final. Interfering with the judging will not be tolerated. The final interpretation of the show rules is the responsibility of the show committee.
10. All entries shall be entered at the sole risk of their owner. The greatest possible care will be given to your entries however, neither the WSRBA nor the Chelan County Expo Center will be responsible for any injury suffered by entrants, their guests, spectators, or animals.
11. Adults will be held liable for damage done by their children or those in their care.
12. Leak proof cages bottoms are required.
13. Please fill out your entry form completely and legibly. You may type your entry in an email. No screenshots or photos of entries will be accepted.
14. Under age animals will not be allowed in the showroom. Animals must meet their breed's minimum weights to be in the showroom.
15. WSRBA reserves the right to refuse entries from locations with which has a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline, we will utilize the ARBA's guidelines.
16. Per ARBA rules-SECTION 52. Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years. An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time.
17. Any rabbits/caviae DQ'd for illness/contagious condition will need to be removed from the showroom.
18. Code of Conduct for our shows: WSRBA expects that all exhibitors, judges, guests, and visitors to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner while attending our shows. Abuse of judges, show staff or other exhibitors will not be tolerated! We strive to maintain an enjoyable and safe gathering for all!
