

2026 DISTRICT 1 YOUTH T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST

Each year, the youth contestants that attend the ARBA Convention and represent District 1 wear team shirts. These shirts are unique and highly sought-after memorabilia. Part of their uniqueness is that the artwork imprinted has been provided by a District 1 Youth.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Youth must be residents of District 1 (Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Alaska, parts of Canada) to be eligible to compete in the District 1 T-Shirt Design Contest. The winner will be announced at the WSRBA Banquet on June 27, 2026 in Cashmere, WA, but contestants need not be present to win. WSRBA membership is NOT required to enter.
2. All artwork must be suitable for a front or back design of a T-shirt. All artwork must be original, signed works.
3. Pencil drawings, line drawings, grayscale sketches, etc. will be accepted, either hand or computer generated. No photographic artwork please.
4. The design must be submitted as a PDF or JPG file.
5. Artwork must include a rabbit and a cavy and either the words "District 1 Team 2026" or "District One Team 2026".
6. In addition, applicants must submit three (3) shirt and print color combinations that they prefer. Available t-shirt colors can be found at [this link](#) (colors subject to availability) and screen print ink comes in all basic colors (black, white, colors of the rainbow, etc.). Designs will be printed in one color. An example color combination that a youth may submit is black shirts with white print.
7. Youth must submit their design online via the [District 1 T-Shirt Design Contest Entry Portal](#). This is a different portal than the one to be used for WSRBA Youth Contest entries. Designs must be submitted in the form of a PDF or JPEG file. Hand-drawn artwork must be scanned and converted into one of these file formats. The submission deadline is 11:59:59 PM PST on May 15, 2026.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Access the [District 1 T-Shirt Design Contest Entry Portal](#). You must have a Google (Gmail) or Google-affiliated account in order to use the online entry portal.
2. Answer the questions on the online entry form.
3. Upload your design. Design files should be in JPEG or PDF format. Please name your document using the following template: "LAST NAME_FIRST NAME_D1_TSHIRT_2026". For example, if Aggie Mowry was entering she would name her file: "MOWRY_AGGIE_D1_TSHIRT_2026". Google will add a name (the name of the person who owns the Google account you are using) to the end of your file name once you upload your document. You will not be penalized for this.
4. Read and mark the checkboxes attesting that you have read the rules of the contest and have parent/guardian permission to participate.
5. Click submit. Your responses and uploaded file has not been submitted until you click submit. Upon submitting your application, you will receive an email with your responses to the questions in the online entry portal. The submission deadline is 11:59:59 PM PST on May 15, 2026.
